#### Introduction

How would you like to live in the future? Can today's politicians and the current economic system solve mankind's future problems?

I would like to present to you my vision for peace, global harmony, the global economy, food and happiness on earth. What I am presenting to you is a complete change to the global political and economic structure.

I am no politician, neither am I a conservationist or a communist. I am a mechanical engineer and head of a medium-sized company with international offices.

I am independent and I am financing this campaign through my own private means.

The basis of our existence, nature, will be destroyed over the coming decades through the economics of unrestrained growth and an unbridled craving for power and money. The era of the current economic system, where capitalism is based on monopolies and banking with the objective of maximum profits, is coming to an end.



People of the world, I call upon you to unite and ensure that immediate and effective steps are taken to prevent the destruction of nature and climate change.

Let us ensure that the wastage of resources on armaments is brought to a halt right now. We waste resources on killing one another. We could wipe each other out completely several times over and destroy the earth with the weapons that we already have. Is that what we really want? How dumb are we?

Let us ensure that oil, gas, agricultural land, important raw materials and water are organised and distributed in accordance with global rules, as the property of humanity. If humanity is no longer permitted to profit from these basic resources, they will no longer give rise to wars. Let us ensure that living conditions are harmonised around the world and that no-one is forced to leave their homeland.

Let us ensure that funds are used for research into better use of renewable energies, organic agriculture, for our health and for the education of our children, and are not wasted on pointless arms.



Global problems can only be resolved in a global and peaceful manner. Wars serve only to boost the profits of the armaments companies.

Artificial Intelligence and Bio Engineering, these hazards and hopes of the future, must be regulated on a global basis.

Through my many years of intercultural work in various regions of the world, I have learned that the people of the world belong together and that they will only have a good life in the future through cooperation and mutual respect, as well as the fair distribution of basic resources such as water, land and energy.

However, I have also learned that thinking and acting on a global basis or an understanding for foreign and unknown cultures is not something that can be assumed of all people. This requires a great deal of time and the will to get to know one another, open-minded cooperation and above all mutual respect.

The idea that I would like to present to you will certainly seem utopian, unrealistic and perhaps even completely



infeasible naive at first glance.

But, is it really?

It is an idea that envisages a global mind-set and cultural exchange, just as it envisages local action and respect for the wishes of the cultures of people in their homeland.

Fairness, tolerance and respect are the foundations for friendship, cooperation and therefore also for a peaceful and happy future for you and your children.

I would like to share this idea with you and hope that you will introduce your own perhaps better suggestions as to how you foresee future co-existence on this planet. We need new visions.

Do not fear reasonable changes that benefit all mankind. Do not allow yourself to be intimidated or manipulated by corrupt politicians or billionaires!



### The road to true globalization, or: an outcry against a sprawling, self destructive capitalism

A **united world government** is not a new concept. Rather, the idea is as old as civilization itself and goes back to the time of the Egyptian kings. Dante, Immanuel Kant and other thinkers have also contemplated the concept.

"Writing in 1795, Immanuel Kant considered World Citizenship a necessary step toward world peace"

Only 10% of the world>s population own 85% of the world>s wealth!

We live in an era of extremely unfair distribution of the world's resources, with grave consequences for humanity.

The resources of the Earth, energy, water and land, are the livelihood of all people:

The distribution of the world>s resources currently seems to enter its final phase.

We are witnessing the violent destabilization of large parts of the Middle East, the beginning of the collapse of the European Union, and the dissolution of whole nations whose



leaders stand against economic interests, particularly those of the United States. We 9 witness large parts of the world becoming ungovernable and descending into violence.

Chaos and violence already rule in Syria, Iraq, Libya, and the Ukraine, and may soon spread to Egypt, Southern Europe, and perhaps other parts of the world as well.

Instead of combating terrorism and uniting the peoples of the world, what has happened was that terrorism was fostered and extreme fascist Islamist movements were allowed to establish a State based on medieval and inhumane principles.

It is the struggle for the world's resources that is currently becoming increasingly aggressive. At stake is a realignment of global power and consequently access to the resources of energy, water, raw materials, and land.

It is a time marked by intolerance and greed, both for power and for money.

No one involved seems to realize that in the end everyone will lose and our society and civilization as we know it today will have been destroyed.



The current refugee flows clearly demonstrate that people can no longer be kept back by walls or borders. What we are currently witnessing is the beginning of a new mass migration towards Europe, a fusion of nationalities and consequently an unstoppable transformation of Europe and the whole world.

This negative development is caused by the extremely unfair distribution of global power and resources, i.e. the concentration of people>s livelihood in the hands of only a few individuals.

Billions of people are impoverished, without clean drinking water or access to the worlds resources, which are instead used wastefully by a couple of industrialized countries in a system based on making maximum profit.

Today, money largely determines the distribution of power and consequently of global resources.

If one looks at the developments of the last 10 years, one will see that the gap between rich and poor nations is ever widening.

This is not only about ownership of energy resources like oil



or gas - above all, it is about an economic gamble with the foundations of people's basic livelihood and about the private ownership of water and land, and thus of food production.

Speculations with food and farmland have dramatically increased food prices in poor countries and must immediately be outlawed.

The immense importance of money and the excessive power it gives to certain individuals, banks, hedge funds, rating agencies or multinational corporations, and their greed for ever more wealth and power will one day lead to a situation where all the world's resources are concentrated in the hands of only a few and no longer accessible to the vast majority.

Against this fatal development we must cry out and resist right now.

Let's not be distracted by the media with issues like refugees and terrorism - these are merely tools to stoke fears and obtain even more control and power over individuals like Yourself.

It is of course difficult to march or protest against such an



invisible and sneaky development. Have you ever wondered who is actually behind Black Rock or mega banks like Goldman Sachs?

The current economic system, which is based solely on the goal gaining maximum profit, must be replaced with a system that fosters responsibility for the welfare of the people.

Money is power, so we must distribute it more fairly to restrict the sums owned and thus the power held. Money should serve as a means to store and pay for material values and services, but it must never be misused as an instrument of power.

Wars are primarily waged to seize control of basic resources like land, energy, and water, and thus to gain power.

Unimaginably large sums of money (power resource) flow into the build-up of weapon stores, whose ultimate goal is war, destruction and killing. Peace is only possible without weapons.

The destabilization of entire regions forces people to focus on mere survival instead of fighting against the system that threatens them.



Are the systematic destabilization and taking of lives and livelihoods followed by a certain stabilization and improvement of living conditions perhaps even a part of this economic system?

After the end of the Cold War, it seemed, that the world was headed toward global peace - a global peace those in power did not want?

We now see first hand how propaganda is used for targeted destabilization of entire regions, and how the world>s superpowers again position themselves against each other and start fighting proxy wars once more.

A massive arms build-up has been going on for years. It is a regular free-for-all: The West against the East. Islam versus Christianity. Sunnis against Shiites. What is this supposed to lead to? The goal is massive destabilization.

The general rule is: More weapons, more wars, more deaths, more misery. Security cannot be achieved with weapons.

Catalysts accelerating this development are:



a) social injustice

b) inadequately enlightening education

c) extremely high profit made with weapons and a powerful arms industry.

If this development continues unabatedly, more and more parts of the world will become ungovernable and slip into anarchy, which inevitably would lead to the downfall of our civilization.

How can a World Government function in the 21st century and why can the world's current issues only be solved with a central global government?

The United World Government should have the following goals:

1. to gradually level global living standards;

2. to fairly distribute the basic resources of humanity, like water and energy and land.

3. to restrict the power of money and to prohibit the production, distribution and use of military weapons.

These goals are the basic objectives of the World Government and must be set out in a global constitution.



To achieve this, the power of money absolutely must be restricted. Energy resources, water and land shall be centrally administrated by the World Government.

Gaining private profits from these resources must be prohibit

These 3 basic resources of humanity should be exempt from private ownership and private ownership of land should be restricted.

### **1.** Basic principles and essential objectives of a World Government

a) Restricting the power of money through the introduction of a central world currency (W\$) and the establishment of a central World Bank. All currently existing currencies are to be liquidated.

b) Global control over the distribution of the 3 basic resources of land, water and energy and consequently an equal distribution of humanity's resources.

c) A uniform global educational system that takes into account regional differences.

d) The elimination of all nation states and the introduction of



administrative zones populated by ethnically and linguistically similar peoples.

e) Worldwide freedom of religion) Strict separation of religion and government

g) A free global capitalist economy with restricted power of money.

h) A global market, which includes the promotion of regional agriculture and the establishment of production facilities in currently underdeveloped areas.

i) A global free labor market and free travel. Initially, the freedom of movement will have to be restricted due to the excessive economical inequality.

j) Disbanding of all armies and destruction of all existing arsenals

k) Establishment of a global armed police force to control conflicts and enforce the basic law of the World Government.

I) Uniform global tax laws

m) Uniform global legislation regarding environmental and



disaster protection

o) A ban on the development, production, and distribution of military weapons, which makes big, transregional armed conflicts much less likely.

p) Introduction of minimum and maximum incomes and maximum property

q) The economic system is fundamentally capitalist with limitations of income and wealth. Private property is allowed and protected up to a maximum of 10,000,000 W\$.

r) Establishment of a unified health system

s) Equality between sexes and races

t) Abolition of current party systems

u) Initially, today's politicians must be excluded from participation in the World Government because of their ties to monopoly and finance capital.

### Ideas for concrete steps to implement this system: Drafting of a constitution (Basic Law)



The constitution, or Basic Law, should be derived from the liberal principles of Western European States and shall be the basis of all legislation. The introduction of direct democracy and electoral law on a global scale is not viable.

Instead, there should be a Supreme Parliament consisting of representatives from regional administrative zones, which decides global matters by majority.

Such parliaments must also be installed in each administrative zone.

Supervising the World Government and its members is of utmost importance and this is the responsibility of the parliament.

The constitution should be drafted by a broad intellectual segment of the populations of all future regional administrative zones.

Today's politicians should be excluded from the drafting process because of their ties to the financial oligarchy.

Members of various professions from all over the world, such as teachers, lawyers, engineers, economists with international



experience, or doctors, who agree with the declared basic objectives of the World Government, should be involved in drafting the constitution. Current leaders of all world religions are also invited.

The transition period between the current world order based on individual nations and the establishment of new structures must be as short and effective as possible.

To achieve this, concrete planning is needed, along with the creation of a legal basis which is then consistently implemented.

### **2.2** Law on the immediate stop of arms production and the destruction of all military weapons

Military weapons and their usage to gain and expand power currently present the biggest threat to our civilization. It will therefore be the biggest challenge, but one of the key tasks, of the World Government to render these arsenals ineffective and to move the current owners of these weapons to surrendering and destroying their arsenals.

### **2.3 Law on the equal global distribution of the 3 basic resources**



Private ownership of the basic resources of water and energy is to be prohibited, land ownership is to be restricted. Tenure of land should be allowed, but only for farming crops and livestock.

Food privately farmed on rented land may be sold at a profit, but the land cannot pass into private ownership.

Private ownership of oil and gas resources is to be prohibited. No profit may be gained from the sale of energy(coal, oil, gas). Any such realized profit is to be invested in the construction and modernization of energy production facilities or in alternative forms of energy.

Legal private ownership of land should be restricted to a maximum of  $5,000 \text{ m}^2$  per person.

Any property above this limit will be expropriated and may be rented back to the former owners, if they use and cultivate it as farmland or for forestry.

Private ownership of water is ruled out. Profits gained from the production and sale of drinking water are to be immediately invested in water purification technology and global water networks.

#### 2.4 Law on environmental protection



The World shall establish Government а central environmental authority, which will analyze the state of environmental degradation caused by, among others, nuclear technoloav. aenetic engineering, and oil and mineral extraction. Measures must be taken to stop and outlaw this environmental destruction. The genetic engineering of food through genetically modified seeds and insecticides presents an incalculable risk with regard to its unforeseeable mutation into new organisms.

The World Government must stop the manufacturing of such products and close down the respective production facilities.

For nuclear power plants a risk assessment shall be performed on the basis of which appropriate measures are to be taken. Investments in alternative energies are to be massively increased

### 2.5 Law on the introduction of a uniform education system

The foundation for achieving a uniform global standard of living is a regionally-adapted, but centrally administrated education system, as well as the building of schools and universities on a global scale. The currently most effective and best education system shall be the basis for the new global education system. The Finnish or German systems



should be taken as a model. Curricula for science subjects and the central language (mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, English) must be centrally specified. Other subjects can be chosen by the regional governments. Uniform global graduation standards are to be specified.

The religious communities are responsible for religious education combined with ethics instruction.

It must be ensured that the basic principles of all religions are taught to all people.

Everyone should be able to freely choose their religious denomination or to choose no denomination at all. No one may belong to a religion by birth.

The training of teachers and the deployment of teachers to regions with currently poor educational standards and/or structural weakness is of utmost importance. The training of teachers and education professionals is to be increased and modeled after the German, Austrian or Swiss system.

Education and religion are to be strictly separated. Global international universities are to be established. The global basis of the education system should be the Buddhist doctrine of right view and right thought. (Ethics instruction)

People need to understand that the meaning of life is to



experience happiness and that happiness can only be experienced when sharing one>s wealth with others. Envy, greed and jealousy only create misery.

Responsibility, happiness and logic thinking must be established as a school subject.

Further focal points in education are the equality of gender,, color and religions.

Education must be free and is to be financed through taxes.

#### 2.6 Law on the abolition of currently existing nations and national boundaries and the introduction of regional administrative areas

The gradual elimination of nation states is the foundation for the introduction of central global structures and laws.

The division of the world into major regional administrative zones should be based on continents and could render eight such major zones:

- A) Europe
- B) North Africa and Arabia
- C) North Asia
- D) South Asia and Australia



- E) Middle Asia
- F) North America
- G) South America
- H) Africa

Regional minor and sub-administrative zones should be integrated into the major administrative zones and administered based on ethnic groups and linguistic regions.

#### 2.7 Law on income and property

In order to achieve a global uniform standard of living and to restrict the power of money, minimum and maximum incomes (by region and profession) must be defined and specified.

The same applies for maximum allowed personal wealth.

The following private income levels are recommended: The minimum wage for 48 hours of work should be W\$6,000 per year.

The maximum income of any individual should not exceed W\$500,000 per year.

The wealth of any individual shall be limited to W\$10 million.



The global economy will experience an enormous upswing because of global development and the fact this income will actually be spent in the real economy. This economic upturn must be environmentally sustainable.

Speculation of any kind must be prohibited.

Everyone has a right to at least 30 hours of paid work per week after completing their education. A minimum wage shall be payable for this work.

Social security benefits are permitted only for those individuals that cannot pursue any work for health reasons or because of disability. This right to work generally applies to both sexes.

The net income (profit) of companies should be based on the number of their employees and limited to W\$70,000 per full-time employee per year.

This would ensure a certain income for every job. Companies may generate maximum profits, but any one local branch shall be limited to 4,000 employees or a net profit of W\$280 million. Company offices shall be located in different administrative zones.



A property of W\$50,000,000 (in real estate, cash, etc.) is allowed for owners of companies with personal liability and therefore special responsibility for society. A maximum property of W\$10,000,000 is suggested for all individuals who do not own a company.

Companies may only be formed as corporations. Employees have the right to buy shares in their companies or to receive part of their wage in form of such shares.

#### 2.8 Birth control and deceleration of population growth

It is expected that due to education, enlightenment and higher income the birth rates, particularly in the currently poor regions of the world, will drastically decline in the medium term. The World Government expects that no law on birth control will be required. Sex education in schools must be expanded and shall be part of the central education system.

#### 2.9 Gender equality

Gender equality is a fundamental principle of the World Government.

This basic principle must be set down in the World Government's constitution.



Men and women must generally be paid equally and women have the same right to work as men. Women shall receive paid leave for pregnancy or child upbringing. Nurseries must be built, and since they are viewed as the basis of the further education system, they shall be financed by taxes.

#### 2.10 Law on the taxation of income and property

Private income up to W\$500,000 annually is tax-free. The same applies for maximum property.

However, a uniform value added tax of 30% is recommended VAT on food, water and energy shall be on 15%. This ensures that the biggest consumers pay the highest share of taxes.

Pricing is unregulated and based on market principles.

Companies must pay a vat of approx. 15%, Taxes are distributed as follows: 5% for the World Government, 5% for the major administrative zone, 5% for the province.

Tax benefits may be granted in specified developing regions. Additional taxes may not be levied. Additional subsidies or tax benefits are prohibited.



Global financial compensation shall ensure that the Central Governments funds are equally distributed.

## 2.11 Law on the introduction of a new central global currency and the establishment of a central World Bank distributing these funds.

Restricting the power of money is one of the most important tasks of the World Government. To achieve this, a new currency, the World Dollar (W\$), shall be introduced and replace all existing currencies. To ensure proper economic cycles after the abolition of all existing currencies, exchange rates for assets are to be introduced.

Loans owned to existing financial institutions are to be declared null and void.

Privately owned financial institutions are to be closed down. Government and semi-government banks become the property of the World Government.

Exchange rates after the currency change are based on the maximum allowed property of individuals or companies.



The World Dollar (W\$) is created by a central World Bank and equals in value the current US Dollar. This means current cash reserves can still be used for payments at current exchange rates until the World Bank has printed enough new cash. All prices are to be given in W\$.

Every citizen of Earth aged 16 or older has the right to have an account with an associated globally valid payment card similar to today>s credit cards. Children under 16 get an account with their parents.

A centralized payment system similar to that of credit cards must be established.

Every destitute citizen of Earth over 16 receives a starting capital of W\$1,000 on their payment card. Destitute parents receive a one-time payment of W\$ 500 for each child.

This seed money may only be used for food, housing and education. Parents receive a starting capital of W\$500 for every child under 16.

Current incomes shall continue to be paid as before, within the limits of the above defined minimum and maximum wages.



Currently existing banks are to be shut down or become the property of the World Bank.

### **2.12** Law on the establishment of a central health care system

It is the World Government>s goal to establish a unified and centralized health care system. Every citizen must take out health insurance. Profits made from the manufacture of medicinal products are to be taxed at a rate of 50%. This tax money is to be invested in research.

So-called conventional medicine as well as alternative or natural medicine shall be supported in the same way.

A global pension and health insurance system is to be introduced.

### **3.** The economic system of the world under a central World Government

Why must the World Government accept and enforce a moderate and modified capitalist social system as the world's basic social order?



Today's social structures are mostly capitalist and / or feudal. Serfdom and slavery are still common in feudal structures in Africa, the Middle East and actually in the entire Orient.

The more societies develop towards capitalist production, the greater the value added and consequently the individual income.

Capitalist society (i.e. the private ownership of the means of production) brings prosperity if it's wealth is distributed fairly.

Considering all previous social orders, from feudalism to socialism and communism, capitalism and capitalist production have proven the social order that has generated the most wealth in industrialized nations.

#### Limited private ownership of the means of production and competition are the basis for the development of society.

One can conclude from this that in order to achieve healthy development, a society not only needs competition, but must also create an incentive for continuously improving and developing the living standard of the people and the satisfaction of their needs.



Economic growth must be decelerated and accompanied by a reduction in the consumption of resources. Therefore, the World Government must initiate special research projects particularly in this area.

The World Government must make a social order characterized by ecological capitalist production and private economy the foundation for the development of its society.

The privately driven social order must be restrained by reducing ownership and money in the hands of individuals. Raising the wealth of the deprived areas is achieved through education and investments in environmental, solar energy and transport projects.

However, this capitalism must be controlled through the restriction of the power of money and of single individuals. In order to achieve a more equal global distribution of power, there must also always be an incentive to increase public wealth or the level of education. (Compulsory education)

People must be able to achieve success in life, but success is not necessarily only measured in wealth. We must try to replace the current atmosphere of envy and jealousy with one of solidarity and a global common identity.



In order to overcome social and economical inequalities, it is essential to promote uniform global industrialization, which can create high-quality jobs and provide an incentive for more education.

Therefore, people with a higher level of education should contribute to the industrialization of today>s industrially underdeveloped areas of the world. The industrial potential in current industrialized countries will not increase, but it will be boosted in currently underdeveloped regions.

The goal should be to locally produce and market products and foodstuffs.

#### All utopian or perhaps a true new way of thinking?

Many may warn against the danger of establishing such a system, as in the hands of the wrong people it could quickly end in global dictatorship.

This risk of course exists. That is why it is so incredibly important that the foundation of the World Government must be a strong constitution. This constitution or Basic Law must be binding for everyone who is responsible on a global or regional level for enforcing the objectives of the World Government.



A strong office for the protection of the constitution and a constitutional court must ensure the enforcement of the constitution.

#### Questions abound

Will people take interest in this concept, organize themselves and develop a legal foundation for World Government?

Can those who currently hold power and property be convinced to surrender their weapons, to restrict their property according to the new guidelines and to submit to the principles of the World Government, to give up or restrict their power?

Will they be wise and far-sighted enough to trade in their power for the benefit of humanity?

Can we convince them that the principles of the World Government are the only way to ensure the survival of humanity?

That war is not winnable, religions cannot be defeated and that birth control can only be achieved through education and enlightenment?



Can we win progressive religious leaders for this idea?

Can we combine the ideas of the World Government with the medieval views of conservative and aggressive Islam and conservative and extremist Christians and Jews?

Can we convince progressive religious leaders to support the idea?

Can we convince lawyers and economists, philosophers and engineers with international experience to help in making this vision come true and to draft a constitution for the World Government that is recognized and supported by most people of the world?

How can we abolish the existing monetary system and replace it with a new world currency?

How will the masses react to the elimination of national borders? No passports, only a global ID card indicating the administrative zone one belongs to?

Are people today already educated enough to understand the reasons behind the World Government and to not feel threatened by it?



Will humanity manage to realize this idea before the next great war?

What should be the stages of this transition?

The transition toward World Government must happen peacefully and quickly.

How will the World Government handle the religious fanatics in Islam, Judaism or Christianity?

Is humanity already able to take such an important step?

Or is the true nature of man that of a power-hungry being and has remained unchanged despite thousands of years of evolution?

The implementation of the ideas outlined above would certainly be a dream come true for many people, while it would be nightmare for some others.

# 4) Parliaments and elections in the provinces and districts

•The parliaments should be re-elected through an online election every 3 years



•Cities, towns and villages should nominate their candidates

•Parliaments will be elected in Grisons, Bavaria, Tyrol, South Tyrol, in Andalusia, in Kaluga Oblast, in the province of Chandong or Sichuan, in Texas, California, Alberta or Chihuahua. Nation states such as Germany, Italy, Switzerland, Austria, Russia, China, USA, Mexico, Canada or Spain will be dissolved

•Local decisions will be made by the parliaments. • In the event of a narrow majority of 55%, a referendum shall be held

•All decisions should be beneficial to humanity

•Expert teams make global decisions, parliaments in the provinces and districts make local decisions.

•Expert teams in the administrative zones are required to communicate closely with the local parliaments

•The administrative language should be English, plus the locally spoken language.
